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## **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

The Cabarrus County Partnership for Children is soliciting proposals for programs to address identified needs for children ages birth to 5 years and their families in Cabarrus County in fiscal years 2019-21. Proposals will be accepted in the following areas:

**Early Care and Education - Quality**  
**Early Care and Education - Workforce**  
**Family Support**  
**Health**

Proposals are especially encouraged that address priorities identified in the 2016 Cabarrus County Needs Assessment – substance abuse, mental health, and obesity. Only Evidence-Based/Evidence-Informed Programming will be accepted. Level 11 Certification is *required* for child care-related activities. For other activities, a bachelor's degree in a Human Service or related field is *preferred*. All proposals shall be for a **two** year bidding term (cycle).
