The Cabarrus County Partnership for Children (CCPC) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization with a mission to connect purpose, people and place to ensure child well-being in Cabarrus County. CCPC is a collaborative organization that contracts with many community partners to implement evidence-based programs in early education, health, and family support.

## Cabarrus County children ages birth to five

- Early literacy programs
  - Reach Out and Read | Working with pediatric doctors to help educate parents on the importance of reading aloud to their children every day
  - Dolly Parton's Imagination Library | Children ages birth to five, who reside in Cabarrus County, may be registered by their parents to receive a free book in the mail every month until they turn 5. If started at birth, the child will have 60 books by their 5th birthday.
- Providing high-quality early education experiences through NC Pre-K
- Improving the quality of child care in Cabarrus County
- Substance abuse care for pregnant mothers at The SUN Clinic
- Parent support groups
- Home-visiting programs
- Emergency dental care for children under 5 years old and are without dental insurance or Medicaid
- Teaching families how to build healthy lifestyles
- Outreach programs for families in need
- Connecting families with local services and resources
- Sharing with pediatric doctors the importance of Developmental Screening and helping with referrals

## Child care providers & early educators

- Training and technical support from Child Care Health Consultants
- Rowan-Cabarrus Community College Early Education Teacher Liaisons and an Early Educator Business Administrator Liaison work to address teacher education and business administrator education in child care facilities
- Connecting providers and educators with local resources and opportunities
