Do you know that Rowan Cabarrus Community College has a Scholarship/Grant program for Early Childhood Educators and Directors that is funded by Cabarrus County Partnership for Children and Smart Start? This scholarship/grant program provides financial and technical support to early educators working with children 0-5 years old in Cabarrus County while pursuing an Associate's Degree in Early Childhood. As a participant of this grant, you will have the opportunity to receive cash stipends when you earn a "B" or higher in your Early Childhood courses by the following awards: \$100 for Intro to Early Childhood, \$150 for each certificate (Child Care Specialist, Infants, Toddlers, and Twos, and Administrator), \$300 for the diploma and \$500 for your associate's degree. Also if you do not qualify for TEACH or Financial Aid, we can receive \$1500 per year to offset the cost of tuition.

For directors of programs that serve children 0-5 years old, the scholarship/grant will provide financial and technical support as you pursue a Certificate in Business Entrepreneurship. This certificate provides directors the opportunity to learn mastery content related to the creation of a business plan, accounting principles, marketing strategies, increase value to your business, and other innovative ethics. This certificate can be completed in two semesters (2 classes in the fall and 2 classes in the spring). Participants will be provided with a laptop equipped with necessary programs for you to be successful in the courses. Scholarships will also be awarded to offset the cost of tuition if you do not qualify for financial aid or receive assistance from T.E.A.C.H. Upon completion of the certificate with a grade of "B" or higher in all four courses, a \$300 cash stipend will be awarded.

Education and quality care for children work well together! So what are you waiting for? These scholarship/grant programs were developed and funded just for you! You have everything to gain and we are here to assist you every step of the way. We look forward to working with you all!
