### THE IMPORTANCE OF WELL-CHILD CHECKS

- Patient health and safety is the Number 1 priority of healthcare providers, and they have worked to ensure their offices are safe for your families.
  - Providers are offering well visits, sick visits, preventative screenings, mental and behavioral health services, and vaccinations.
- Missing routine health check-ups may put children at risk for health issues.
- Getting vaccinations on time can help children become immune to serious diseases before they become exposed to them.
- Well-visits are a chance to talk with your child's provider about questions and concerns related to your child's health.
- Children who are not protected by vaccines are more vulnerable to preventable diseases such as measles and whooping cough (pertussis).
- The CDC and the AAP recommend that you continue scheduling your child's well-child visits and stay upto-date with vaccines. This is especially important for children under 2 years of age and for children with special health care needs.

Feel free to contact your child's health care provider to see what precautions their office is taking to keep patients safe.
