



## THE IMPORTANCE OF WELL-CHILD CHECKS

- Patient health and safety is the **Number 1** priority of healthcare providers, and they have worked to ensure their offices are safe for your families.
  - Providers are offering well visits, sick visits, preventative screenings, mental and behavioral health services, and vaccinations.
- 
- ◆ Missing routine health check-ups may put children at risk for health issues.
  - ◆ Getting vaccinations on time can help children become immune to serious diseases before they become exposed to them.
  - ◆ Well-visits are a chance to talk with your child's provider about questions and concerns related to your child's health.
  - ◆ Children who are not protected by vaccines are more vulnerable to preventable diseases such as measles and whooping cough (pertussis).
  - ◆ The CDC and the AAP recommend that you continue scheduling your child's well-child visits and stay up-to-date with vaccines. *This is especially important for children under 2 years of age and for children with special health care needs.*

**Feel free to contact your child's health care provider to see what precautions their office is taking to keep patients safe.**
