The Executive Committee of the Cabarrus Partnership for Children met Tuesday, September 24, 2019, at 8:00 a.m. at Ellie's Restaurant. These members were present: Cheryl Kelling and Jackie Whitfield. The SUN Project was approved by NCPC, and a proposal has been received and we are hoping to allocate funds for the program at the October board meeting. The Partnership is also applying for a Robert Wood Johnson grant for the SUN Project, if we receive the grant, we will not have to use Smart Start funding.

We will launch the Coat Drive sometime in October. Debbie Wilkinson is hopeful going to help us, but we are looking for new folks to help. Jackie Whitfield suggested we contact Pam Dubois and Hilary Smith.

The next Board Meeting is scheduled for October 29th (Which is a change) at noon at All Saints Episcopal Church
