## **Executive Summary:**

**Child Care Quality** improved slightly but remained relatively stable from 2022 to 2023. Percentage of enrollment in 4 and 5 star facilities for **Cabarrus are above NC (Cabarrus 75.5% compared to NC 71%)**. **Cabarrus remains above high performing standard overall** and above standard for ages 0 and 5.

**Teacher Education** still **remains below minimum standard** but did increase from previous year. **Below NC** (Cabarrus 48.1% compared to NC 55%)

**Administrator Education** increased and remained **above high performing standard** and above **state average** (Cabarrus 75.7%, NC 71%).

**Child abuse and neglect** is below NC rate, 4.53%, Cabarrus compared to 5.9%, NC. The Cabarrus rate is just below the target range.

**Early intervention/special education saturation rate equal to NC** for ages 0-2 (Cabarrus 5.8%, NC 5.8%) and above NC for ages 3-5 (Cabarrus 3.4%, NC 2.7%). Ages 3-5 went down 2.8 percentage points from 6.2% to 3.4%, **moving outside goal range**. Explanations for this movement are being explored.
