



NAUSEA/VOMITING/FEVER and COVID in CHILDCARE:

Child care programs are required to:

- Exclude children and adults from the child care facility who have tested positive for COVID-19. [Required by NC GS § 130A-144.]
- Immediately notify the local health department if they have reason to suspect that a person within the child care facility has COVID-19. [Required by NC GS § 130A-136 and Communicable Disease Rule 10A NCAC 41A .0101 (50-52)]
- Exclude children if:
 - o The child has a fever taken by any method, including at armpit or orally:
 - A child older than two months has a temperature of 101 degrees Fahrenheit or higher.
 - An infant younger than two months has a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher.
 - o Has two or more episodes of vomiting within a 12-hour period or
 - o Has more than two stools above the child's normal pattern and diarrhea is not contained by a diaper or when toilet-trained children are having accidents
 - o Is unable to participate comfortably in activities.
 - o Has symptoms that result in a need for care that is greater than the staff members can provide without compromising the health and safety of other children. [Required by North Carolina Child Care Rules 10A NCAC 09.0804 and .1720(a)]
